- Maximum number of trainees to be accepted for reimbursement: 12
- Eligibility criteria:
- Trainees from COST Full Members/COST Cooperating Member, from approved NNC institutions; from approved European RTD Organisations
- Early Career Investigators (PhD students, PhD + 5 years)
- Knowledge on basic molecular methods
- Preference to scientists working in the field of ME/CFS, but
 others are not excluded

SELECTION OF APPLICANTS

- All the candidates applied by submitting CV and motivation letter. All of them were from COST Full Members/COST Cooperating Member, from approved NNC institutions.
- Seven of applicants (Latvia/3, Spain/2, Italy/1, Belarus/1) fulfilled all of requirements listed in the Call. They were included in the list of participants first.
- Selection of remaining 5 (from 8) participants could be based on two principles: as many EUROMENE countries as possible have participants in the training school or priority based on the date of submission.

FIRST TRAINING SCHOOL

Conclusions and problems to consider when organizing next school

- Efficient instrument for disseminating knowledge to increase capacity of ME/CFS research by involving Early Carrier Investigators (ECI), including from new EU member states
- High interest from ECIs site in this activity (15/12)
- Allmost 47% (7/15) involvement of ECIs from the new EU member states

Conclusions and problems to consider when organizing next school

- The Program of training school should be published on the EUROMENE Website
- More time is needed for selection of applicants (between deadline for applications and selection results)
- Better coordination between Scientific Committee members is needed
- More practical sessions
 - Trainers substitutes should be indicated
